- 1. A guest accidentally breaks a glass bottle in your house? How will you discard the broken glass pieces?
- A) You collect the broken glass pieces and directly throw it in the dry waste bin.
- B) You collect the broken glass pieces, carefully wrap them in a waste cloth or roll them in thick newspaper and then throw it in the dry waste bin.
- 2. Guests have consumed lot of Soda and Cola. There is a heap of trash consisting too many plastic bottles. Many of those bottles have their caps missing and the plastic rings are seen lying around the whole house. How will you discard them?
