Nature's flying gardener, helping forests grow by spreading seeds at night.



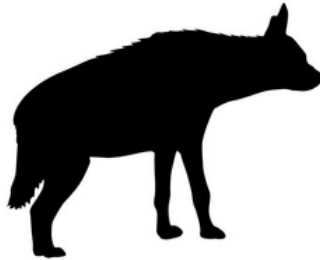
Also known as the "Ghost of the Forest", this large and powerful bird has a deep, eerie call.

A scavenger that roams the forests and dry plains under the cover of darkness, feeding on carcasses and small prey.



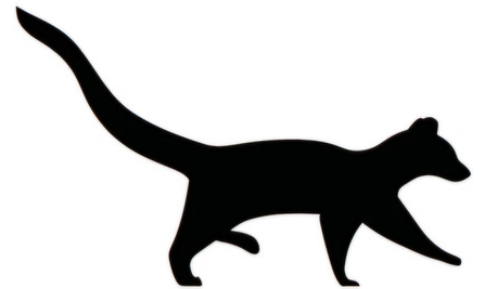
A shy, scaly mammal that emerges at night to hunt for ants and termites using its sticky tongue.

A nocturnal, secretive mammal with a masked face and bushy tail, known for its agility and love for fruits.



One of India's "Big Four" venomous snakes, it is highly active at night and responsible for many snake bite incidents.
