Answer: Fishing nets (Bycatch in the fishing industry).

Answer: Road traffic (Leopard accidents while crossing highways).

3. I am a jackal, sniffing for food. I find something tasty in a big, smelly pile, but it makes me sick. What did I eat?

Answer: Plastic waste (Jackals eating food from garbage dumps).

4. I am a sea turtle looking for jellyfish to eat. I see something floating and swallow it, but it doesn't taste right. What did I just eat?

Answer: Plastic pollution (Plastic bags in the ocean).

5. I am a small bird flying at night. I follow the moon, but then I see a bright red glow and get confused. I fly toward it and crash. What tricked me? Answer: <u>Light pollution (Birds getting disoriented by city lights).</u>

Answer: Feeding wildlife (Monkeys becoming dependent on human food).

- 9. I am a peacock sitting on a tree. Suddenly, a loud explosion shakes the sky, and I panic! I fly into a pole and get hurt. What scared me?

  Answer: Firecrackers (Noise pollution disturbing birds and animals).
- 10. I am a vulture searching for food. I find a dead cow and start eating, but I feel dizzy and weak. Soon, I can't fly. What poisoned me?

  Answer: <u>Veterinary drugs (Diclofenac poisoning in vultures).</u>
- 11. I am a stray dog living in the city. I drink water from a roadside puddle, but it tastes strange. Later, I feel sick and can't stand. What was wrong?

  Answer: Water pollution (Toxic chemicals in urban drains).
- 12. I am a hornbill looking for a tree to build my nest. But all the tall trees are gone, and I can't find a safe home. What happened to my forest?

  Answer: Logging and habitat loss (Tree-cutting reducing nesting sites).



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
